Day 9 St. Petersburg (B,L,D)

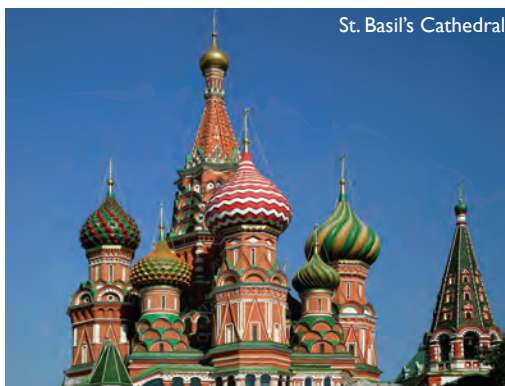
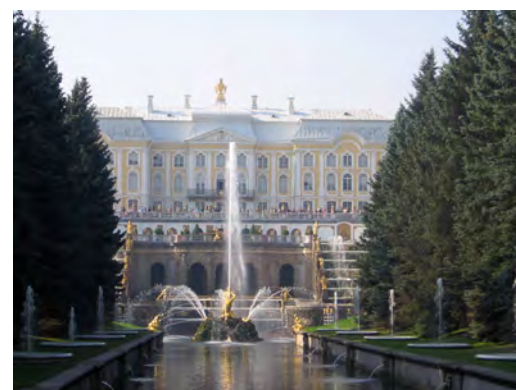
